



THIS DRAWING DEPICTS A TYPICAL HOMEOWNER DRIP IRRIGATION SYSTEM. [SEE "DRIP GUIDELINES" AT IrrigationTutorials.com.](http://IrrigationTutorials.com)

DO NOT USE GALV. STEEL OR STEEL PIPE AFTER FILTER AS IT WILL FLAKE OFF RUST INTO THE WATER & PLUG EMITTERS. BE SURE CONTROLLER ALLOWS VALVE CIRCUIT SETTINGS UP TO 60 MINUTES OF RUN TIME PER VALVE.

CONTROLLERS AND ANTI-SIPHON VALVES ARE THE SAME TYPE AS USED FOR SPRINKLER SYSTEMS. ANTI-SIPHON VALVES MUST BE AT LEAST 6 INCHES HIGHER THAN ANY OF THE EMITTERS. IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE USE A REDUCED PRESSURE OR DOUBLE CHECK TYPE BACKFLOW PREVENTER WITH GLOBE VALVES. SEE THE BACKFLOW PREVENTER PAGE AT IrrigationTutorials.com FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
